

In 1968 the city of Stockholm became a part of the county of Stockholm. The new county got the county code 01 and the county code 02 was no longer used.

In 1997 the counties Malmöhus län and Kristianstads län were merged together to form Skåne län. The new county got the county code 12 and the county code 11 was no longer used.

In 1998 the counties Göteborgs och Bohus län, Älvsborgs län and Skaraborgs län were merged together to form Västra Götalands län. The new county got the county code 14 and the county codes 15 and 16 were no longer used.
